## Morning Time:

As you pick your child up:

- Say good morning.
- Tell them how important they are to you and how glad you are that they are a part of your family.
- Today we are going to help people.

## Morning Prayer Time:

Dear Jesus, thank you for my food. Please help me today to help people who need help.



## Play Time:

Today be on the lookout for opportunities to help:

- Supply dolls or soft toys with bandaged arms/legs and or with band aids. Let the children wrap them in blankets and care for them. Tell them how kind they are to care for the toy.
- Look at some picture books with pictures of people who help us, such as nurses, Doctors and fire fighters. Talk about how good it is to help people.
- Help your child find some toys or clothes that they can give to a friend.
- Help them bake a muffin or savoury to give to a neighbour.



## Bed Time:

- Read or tell your child a story from the Bible or Gracelink lesson. Encourage the child to do the suggested actions. Tell them that we can show love too.
- Ask them how they feel about Jesus making people strong. How does it make you feel to help others?



## Prayer Time:

- Hug your child and encourage them to say a short prayer.
- Pray thanking God for today, His love and care. Ask for His help to remember to help others.

**Big Question:**  
How can I tell  
others about  
Jesus today?

## Big Verse:

"**Tell about** (put hands on mouth) **the wonderful things** (cross arms then spread them out wide) **God** (point upwards) **has done** (put one fist into the open palm of the other hand) "  
**Psalm 105.2** (palms together, then open).



## Morning Time:

- As you pick your child up:
  - Say good morning.
  - Tell them how much you love them and how glad you are that God was with them while they slept.
  - Today we are going to tell someone about Jesus.

## Morning Prayer Time:

"Dear Jesus, Thank you for my breakfast. Please be with me today as I talk to someone about you"



## Play/bath Time:

During the following activities talk about loving people:

- Water some plants together and talk about how great water is, because it makes the plants grow.
- Use or make a little boat and float it in the bath tub. Encourage your child to splash the water with their hands. Talk about how sometimes when the ocean can get rough and stormy God sends His angels to care for people. Talk about how Paul had a boat that got wrecked.
- Take your child to a friend's house and encourage them to tell their friend that they love Jesus.



## Bed Time:

- Read or tell your child a story from the Bible or GraceLink lesson. Involve your child by encouraging them to do the suggested actions.
- Talk about how wonderful God is and ask them who they would like to tell



## Prayer Time:

- Hug your child and encourage them to say a short prayer.
- Pray thanking Jesus for caring for us just like Paul. Help me show others your love.

**Big Story:**  
Angels Sing to  
the Shepherds  
Luke 2 , 1 Thessa-  
lonians 4:16,17

**Big Question:**  
How can I show  
God's love to  
others today?

## Big Verse:

"The Lord . . . said, "I love you (point upward) love you, love you."  
(fold arms over chest) the Lord . . . said, "I love you. (point upward)  
I love you" (fold arms over chest).  
Jeremiah 31:3 (palms together, then open).



## Morning Time:

- As you pick your child up:
  - Say good morning.
  - Tell them how much you love them.
  - Tell them how much God love's them too.

## Morning Prayer Time:

"Dear Jesus, thank you for breakfast and thank you for loving and caring for me. Amen"



## Play Time:

As you do the following activity talk about the birth of Jesus:

- Play Christmas music and talk about how the angels sang when Jesus was born.
- Have the child dress up in a white tee-shirt as angel robes. Sit on fluffy pillows and pretend that you are the clouds in the sky. Talk about what present they would like to give Jesus when they see Him.
- Talk about something that you can do this Christmas to show God's love to others (donate to charity, have someone over for a meal, send cards saying how much you love them to family).



## Bed Time:

- Read or tell your child a story from the Bible or Gracelink lesson. Involve your child by encouraging them to do the suggested actions.
- Talk about how God loves us and that He is coming back to take us to live with Him in Heaven. Ask them how it makes them feel.



## Prayer Time:

- Hug your child and encourage them to say a short prayer.
- Pray thanking Jesus for His love and care. Say that we are looking forward Him coming back to take us to heaven.
