Big Bible:

Big Verse:

Family Discussion:

- Share a time when you helped and it was fun.

- How does God feel when we help Him?

Family Discussion:

Big Bible:

Big Verse:

Family Discussion:

- Share a way you can obey someone this week.
- How can you obey God?
- What can you do to obey your parents too?



Family Challenge: Obedience is really important to people's safety. As a family take a short road trip to have a picnic, take a walk, fly a kite or whatever you enjoy doing together. Along the way talk about all the guidelines that we follow when we travel, play, eat etc. Say a prayer thanking God for the guidance that he gives us. Big Bible:

Big Verse:

Family Discussion:

- What happens if you don't follow instructions?
- How can we learn to follow instructions?



Family Challenge: As a family activity blindfold someone and set out an obstacle course in your house.
