Morning Time:

As you pick your child up:

Morning Prayer Time:

Play/Bath Time:

Big Worship Idea:

I can talk to Jesus every day.

Big Story:

Daniel and the Lions Daniel 6:1-23

Big Question:

How can we talk to Jesus today?

Big Verse:

"Daniel (point with index finger) went into his room (walk with fingers) three times a day (hold up three fingers) to pray (palms together as praying)"

Daniel 6:10 (palms together, then open).



Morning Time:

- As you pick your child up:
 - Say good morning
 - Tell them how much you love them.
 - Tell them how glad you are that Jesus loves them too.
 - · Today we are going to talk to Jesus in prayer

Morning Prayer Time:

"Dear Jesus, thank you for loving me and listening to my prayer"



Play Time:

During the following activities talk about how praying is talking to Jesus:

- Pray by the window just like Daniel.
- Look for pictures of lions and/or visit a zoo and talk about how fierce lions are.
- Make a lion's den with chairs and put toy animals inside. Pray inside your "Den". Have turns hiding and making roaring sounds
- so that you can be found
- Decorate a paper angel and put on the wall above bed.



Bed Time:

- Read or tell your child a story from the Bible or GraceLink lesson.

Big Grace Idea:

God loves and cares for me.

Big Story:

Joseph's New Coat Genesis 30:22-24; 37:1-3

Big Question:

How can i show God's love to others today?

Big Verse:

"Jesus (point to upward) cares (cross arms over chest) for you (point to others)"

1 Peter 5:7 (palms together, then open).



Morning Time:

- As you pick your child up:
 - Say good morning
 - Tell them how much you love them.
 - Tell them that they are a special gift from God.
 - Talk about how we are going to have an amazing day.

Morning Prayer Time:

"Dear Jesus, thank you for loving me and caring for me. Amen"



Play Time:

As you do the following activity talk about Gods love and care:

- Wrap child in a brightly covered blanket. Cuddle them and tell them that they are a special gift.
- Look at the colours in your child's clothes and help them name all the colours.
- Place items in a wrapped box to represent gifts (food, shoes, clothes, toys). Let you child remove them one at a time and thank Jesus for each gift.
- Help your child wrap a gift to give away.
- Tell them that they are your gift.



Bed Time:

- Read or tell your child a story from the Bible or GraceLink lesson. Involve your child by encouraging them to do the suggested actions.
- Ask: "I wonder how God shows His love to us? What gift does He give?"



Prayer Time:

- Hug your child and encourage them to say a short prayer.
 - Pray thanking Jesus for His love and care. Thank Him for all the good things that He has given to us. We love you Jesus.
